Short description of the lecture:

There are numerous researches, so as information from the practice that projects are still suffering about the performance. Latest report from PriceWaterhouse confirm that “86% of projects fail to deliver against their budget, schedule, scope,, quality and benefits baseline”. It is huge problem for business, but also for a society, because of many public project failures. Beside numerous causes, the capacities of project definition and management are recognized like important cause of the poor results. Recent experiences confirmed that advancing project management capacities and competences significantly contribute in positive trend change. The most of the research findings point to project early phases and development of the gate model approach for project approval and start-up. In such approaches the critical part deals with project stakeholder management, so as risk and changes management.
